

## **2026 SALEM SPEEDWAY SCRAPPER RULES**

### **ELIGIBLE CARS**

- 1) Any 4- and 6-cylinder cars, SUV's and minivans are eligible with a maximum of 22 feet long.
- 2) No four-wheel drive or all-wheel drive vehicles allowed.
- 3) No trucks.
- 4) No full-frame vehicles, no turbos and no superchargers permitted.
- 5) Must remove all glass except the windshield. Must remove all headlights and taillights and all airbags
- 6) Any extra items like spare tires, jacks, parts, or trash must be removed from the vehicle prior to going on the racetrack.
- 7) 400 treadwear tires only, no made for racing tires allowed.
- 8) Stock bumpers only, no homemade bumpers allowed.
- 9) No passengers are allowed.

### **SAFETY EQUIPMENT**

- 1) All vehicles must have a door plate the length of the driver's door and gas tank must remain in stock location.
- 2) Drivers must wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants. (Racing uniforms are highly recommended.)
- 3) Helmet must be at least Snell 2015 or newer and must be worn at all times when the vehicle is on the racetrack.
- 4) Must have at a minimum a bolted-in seat and working stock-style seat belts. (A race seat with a five-point harness is recommended.)
- 5) Driver's Side Window Net is required.
- 6) Scanner to monitor race control for the driver is required.

### **REGISTRATION/FEATURE LINE-UP**

- 1) Each driver will need to register and pick up a track transponder at the Pit Sign-in Booth.
- 2) Driver and any team members in the pit area must have purchased a pit pass.
- 3) The scoring computer will draw your feature starting position for you when picking up your transponder and registering. Line-up will be determined once the Scrapper practice is completed. Any cars arriving after the practice will start on the tail of the field.
- 4) Each car must have a readable number on both sides.
- 5) Must have a properly mounted track transponder properly secured (in a transponder bag) under the vehicle with no metal between the transponder and the racetrack before coming on the racetrack for practice. Must make at least one lap in practice to make sure your transponder is working. Turn in your transponder at the Pit Sign-in Booth when you're done racing!
- 6) Previous feature winner must start the next feature he races in on the tail of the field, if that driver wins that event, he gets a \$100 bonus.

### **RACE PROCEDURES**

- 1) Cars need to stay on the racing surface and cross the scoring loop in turn one in order to be properly scored for the event, no driving through the grass on purpose.
- 2) No racing on bare rims! The short track sustained some damage at some events last season from vehicles trying to race on their rims! If you have a bare rim, please pull it off the track immediately! You will be black flagged immediately if you have a bare rim.
- 3) We will just use the green and red flags, not yellows. Go on green, stop immediately when you see the red.

### **Claim Rule**

- 1) The track may claim any car for \$500, excluding safety equipment, at anytime.

**It is your responsibility to see that your car is legal. No equipment will be considered as having been approved by reason of having passed through tech inspection unobserved.**

In keeping with Salem Speedway's commitment to maintaining proper balance in the competition arena, it may be necessary for Salem Speedway to make rule changes and/or rule modifications from time to time. Such changes are designed to enhance close competition. For competitive balance, Salem Speedway reserves the right to change, modify, delete or add to any guidelines as deemed necessary throughout the season.
